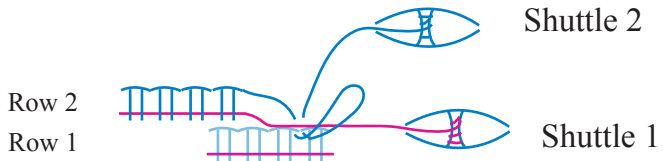


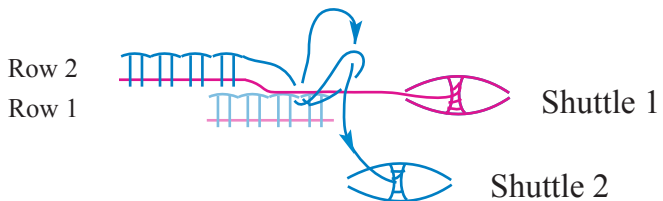
Catherine Wheel Join

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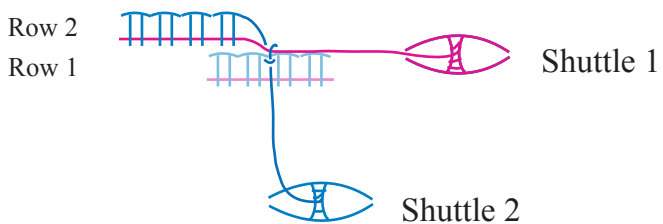


Step 1. Put the core thread (pink) along the top of the double stitches of the previous row.

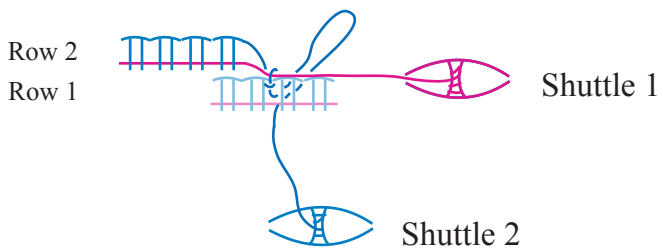
Step 2. From the front, pull a loop of ball thread (blue) through a gap between double stitches. Make sure the core thread is above and behind the blue loop.



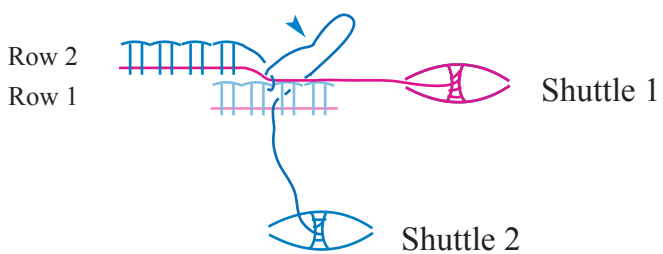
Step 3. Put shuttle 2 through the ball thread loop from back to front, making sure core thread is encapsulated.



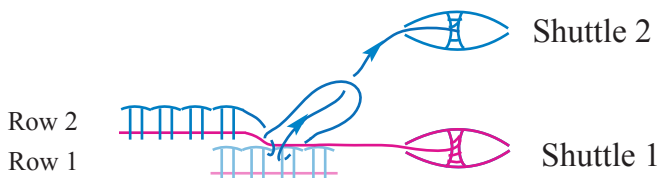
Step 4. Hold shuttle 2 in front of your work and below the double stitches.



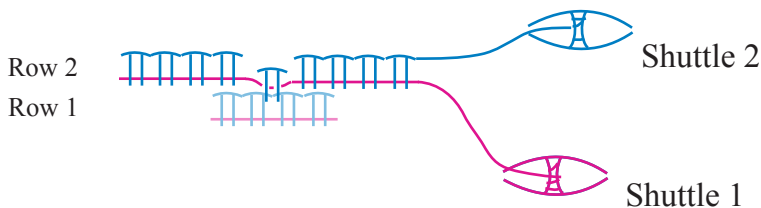
Step 5. Pull Shuttle 2 thread between double stitches from front to back, forming a loop of shuttle 2 thread in back.



Step 6. Pull loop of shuttle 2 thread (at blue arrow) toward the back to "pop" the loop from steps 1 and 2 to the back side. This now forms the first half of a double stitch. Tighten up this first half double stitch.



Step 7. Put shuttle 2 through blue loop from front to back. This forms the 2nd half of the double stitch. Tighten up.



Step 8. Continue tatting as before.
