

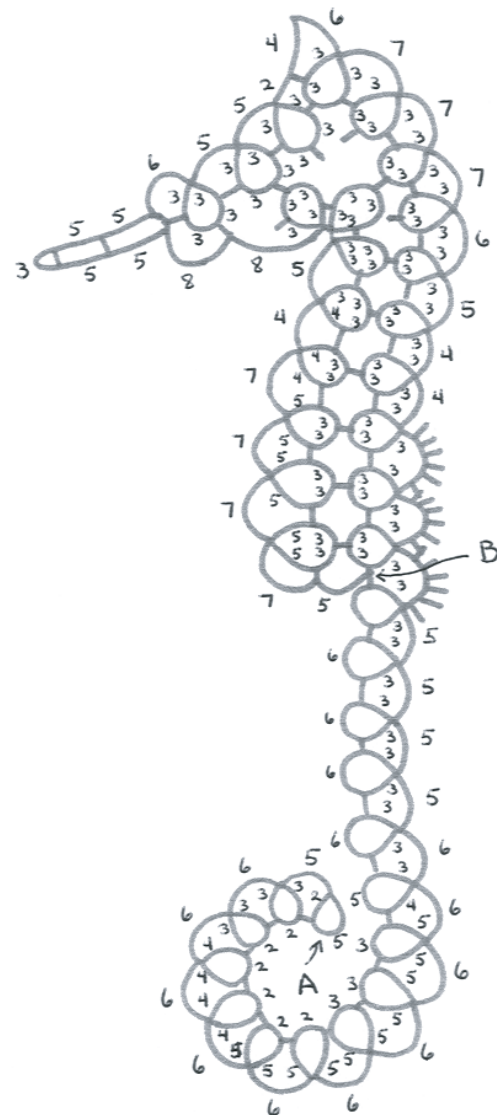
**Materials needed:** 2 shuttles. Any size thread.  
 Using size 20 thread, the sea horse will measure 4 ½" by 2".

**Abbreviations and symbols**

- R □ ring
- C □ chain
- RW □ reverse work
- SS □ switch shuttles
- □ picot
- □ long picot
- + □ join
- 1x □ repeat one time.
- 2x □ repeat two times.
- Nx □ repeat N times.

Wind about 6 yards (size 20) thread onto shuttle 1. Do not cut thread. Wind off about 4 yards from ball. Cut thread. Wind 3 yards onto shuttle 2, leaving about a yard between the two shuttles. Start at A with shuttle 1.

- R (Shuttle 1) 5-2. RW. C 5. RW.
- R 3+2-3. RW. C 6. RW. Repeat 1x.
- R 4+2-4. RW. C 6. RW. Repeat 1x.
- R 5+2-5. RW. C 6. RW. Repeat 1x.
- R 5+3-5. RW. C 6. RW. Repeat 2x.
- R 4+5-3. RW. C 6. RW.
- R 3+6-3. RW. C 5. RW. Repeat 3x.
- R 3+6-3. RW.
- C 1--1--1--1--1--1--1. RW. R 3+3-3-3. RW. Repeat 2x.
- C 4. RW. R 3+3-3-3. RW. Repeat 1x.
- C 5. RW. R 3+3-3-3. RW.
- C 6. RW. R 3+3-3-3. RW.
- C 7. RW. R 3+3-3-3. RW. Repeat 2x.
- C 6. RW. SS.
- C 4 + (to last picot, previous ring) 2. Do not RW.
- R (Shuttle 1) 3+3-3-3. RW. C 5. RW. Repeat 1x.
- R 3+3-3-3. RW.
- C 6 + (to last picot, previous ring). RW. SS.
- C 5-5-3+ (to previous picot, this chain) 5+ (to 1st picot, this chain) 5+ (last picot of previous ring). RW. SS.
- C 8+ (to middle picot, previous ring) 8. RW.
- R 3-3+3-3. R 3+3+3-3. R 3+3+3-3. RW.
- C 5. RW. R 3+3+3-4. RW.
- C 4. RW. R 4+3+3-4. RW.
- C 7. RW. R 5+3+3-5. RW.
- C 7. RW. R 5+3+3-5. RW. Repeat 1x.
- C 7 + (to picot of previous ring) 5.
- Cut and tie to picot at B. Hide ends.



**Note for those who tat front side/back side:** The sea horse will face left if you tat the rings front side. The sea horse will face right if you tat the rings back side.
